

Weinheimer receives national 2017 CSAA Service Award

Evelyn Weinheimer has received the 2017 Service Award from the Country School Association of America.

Weinheimer is the archivist and tour coordinator at Pioneer Museum, and in the nomination application, she is credited as "an extraordinary worker for Gillespie County Historical Preservation and the Country Schools."

Jane Woellhof, director-at-large of the Friends of Gillespie County Country Schools, presented the award at the Pioneer Museum recently.

"Her knowledge and willingness to assist others in learning about their family history is often begun with the question, 'Can you tell me if my grandfather attended one of the Gillespie County Country Schools?'" Woellhof said.

The award comes with a cash stipend, which Weinheimer has donated for further maintenance and care of

the White Oak School on the Pioneer Museum campus.

Weinheimer was born in and grew up in Fredericksburg, and attended and graduated from Fredericksburg public schools.

She attended North Texas State University in Denton

and graduated with a bachelor of science degree in elementary education.

Her first teaching job was in Austin teaching fourth, fifth and sixth grade.

Fifteen years after high school graduation, she and her husband brought their

family back to Fredericksburg to live and operate a cabinet business. She taught 15 years at Fredericksburg Elementary School, mostly fifth grade.

Upon retirement, she has worked part-time as a travel counselor and now works for the Pioneer Museum.
